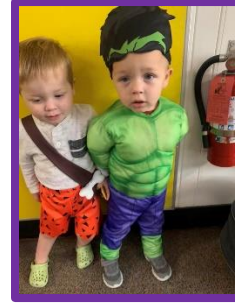


This week we had lots of fun! We sorted Goldfish crackers by color and then counted them. We also did some fun fall painting!

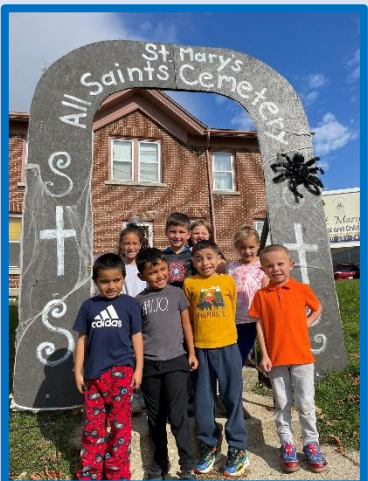
