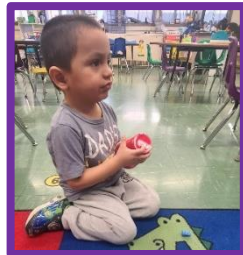

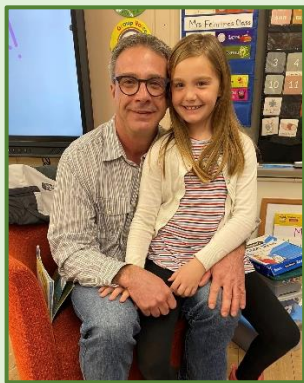

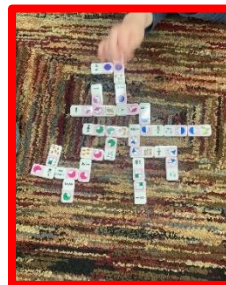

MYSTERY READER



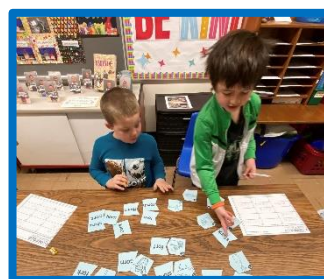
Second Grade was very lucky to have Madilyn's Grandpa come in for our March Mystery Reader. They loved the stories that were read, thank you!
