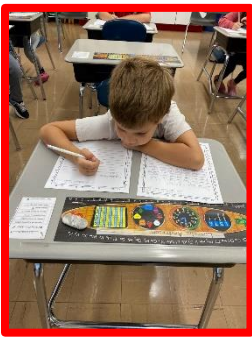


On Sunday, Oct. 1st our students were invited to sing at Mass at St. Mary's Church. We had a great turnout and they all did so well!

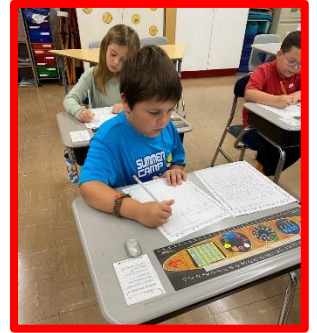
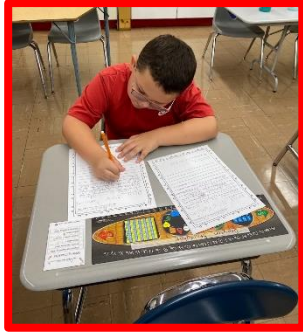

Our childcare kids took a walk and enjoyed Friday's beautiful weather! We did lots of crafts this week, and spent time in activity centers and worked on our motor skills.



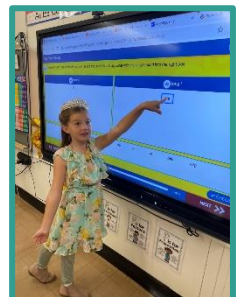
Ebert's Farm FIELD TRIP NOTES:
