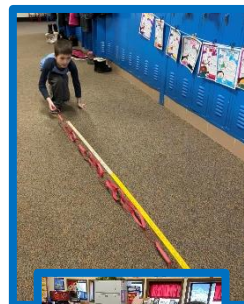
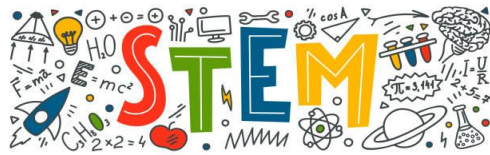

Miss Diane's 3K class worked hard on an art project this week. It will be on display at our Open House on Sunday, Jan. 29th. Stop by to see it!



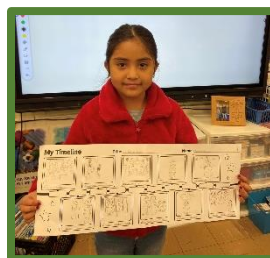

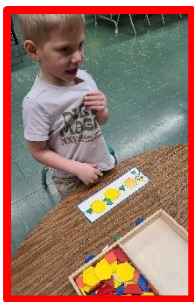


2nd graders working on their shared reading and doing partner work.
