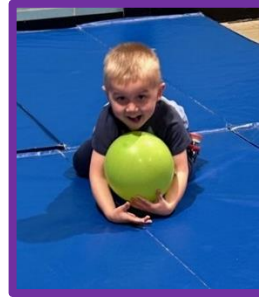
During STEAM, students created Ducky Launchers to help learn about potential and kinetic energy. They had several materials to choose from and were excited when their little rubber duckies popped into the air.

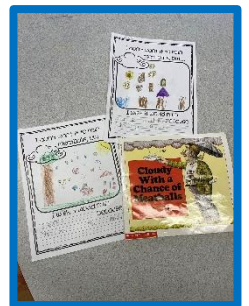
We did a balloon obstacle course in the gym this week and it was so much fun!
