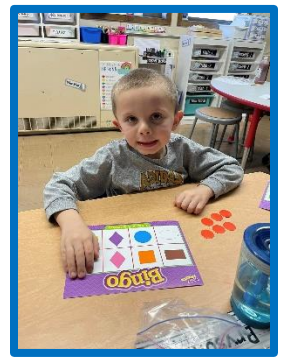

# 3K ADVENTURES

In 3K this week, we worked on some fine motor skills and practiced recognizing the first letters of our names. We also got to help Jose celebrate his half-birthday!

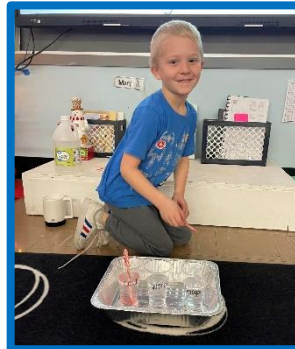


Our 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> graders made nativity ornaments during religion class this week.
