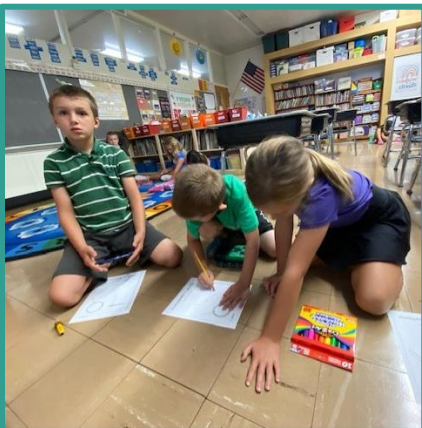


STEAM
