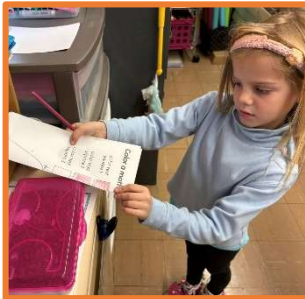
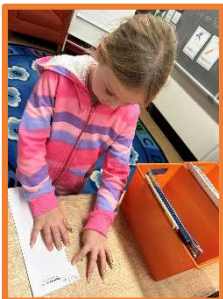
We have been learning about emotions and how to write about them. In math we did some turkey centers! In religion, we learned about forgiveness and thanking our families.

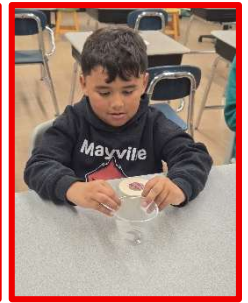

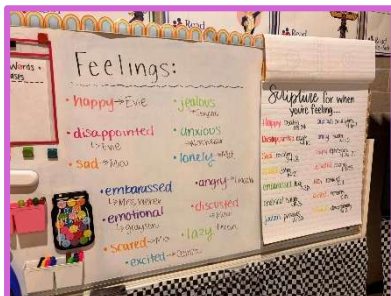

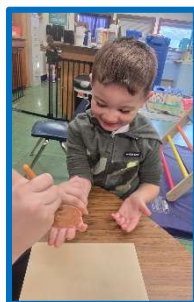
# 4TH GRADE
