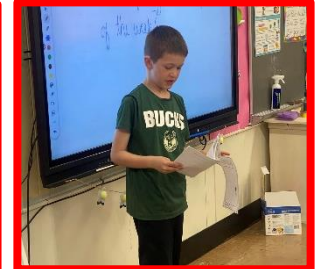
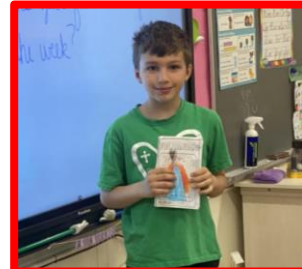
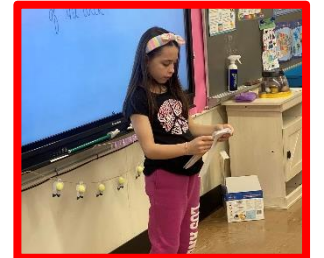
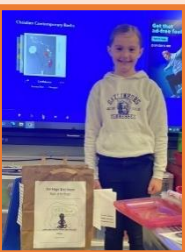
Our littles were busy! We planted flowers, visited Mrs. Fehring's baby chicks and played in centers!

Third grade reading presented their reports on natural disasters after reading "I Survived Hurricane Katrina" by Lauren Tarshis. We all learned some interesting facts!

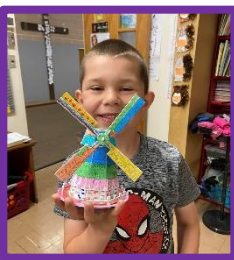
