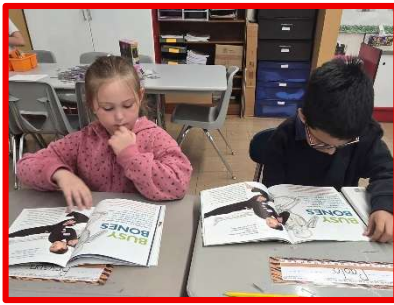
1ST GRADE

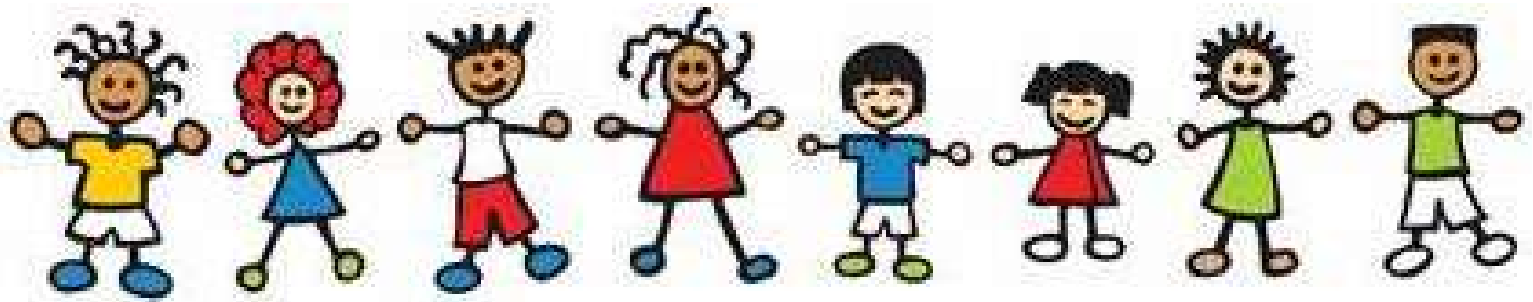
4TH GRADE
