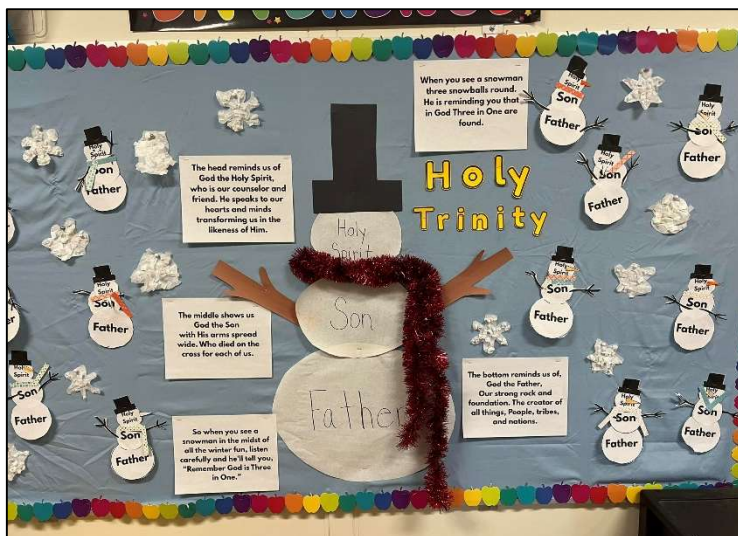

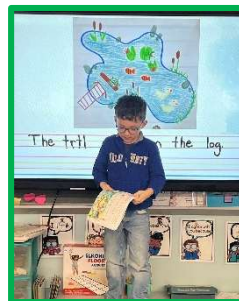

There's lots to talk about in 1st grade!

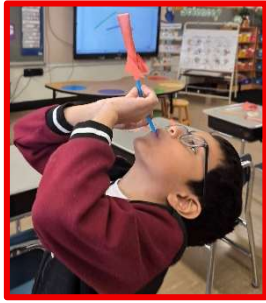
- We started doing place value in math.

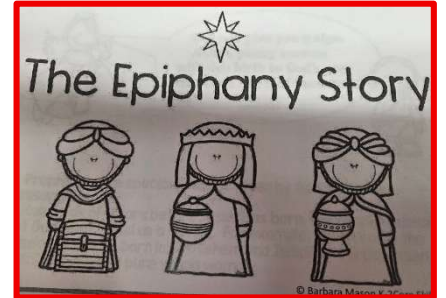

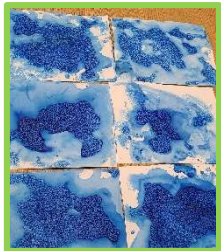
We had a busy week in 2nd grade....

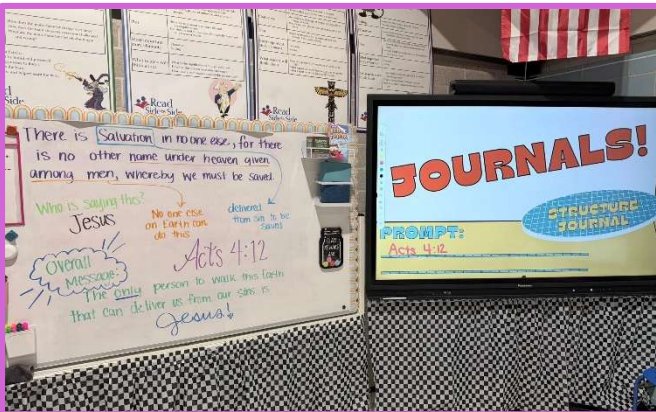
Third and fourth grade presented their past and present research paper to the first and second graders. We all learned something new!

3RD GRADE



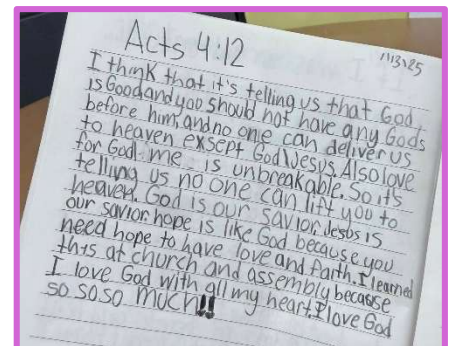
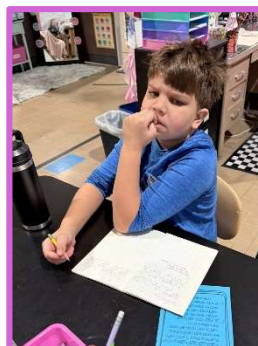

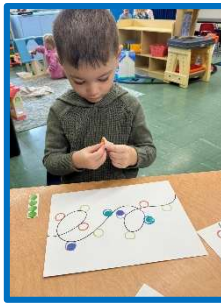
