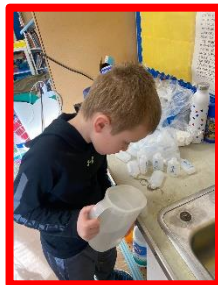
Our second grade students are preparing for the Sacrament of First Holy Communion.
