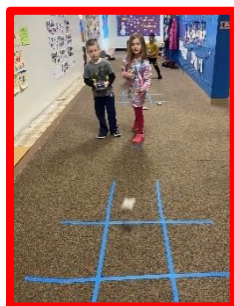

Our 3K - 2nd graders all went out for a morning recess together, so we couldn't pass up getting this great group photo!

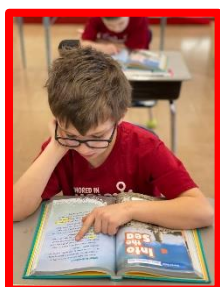
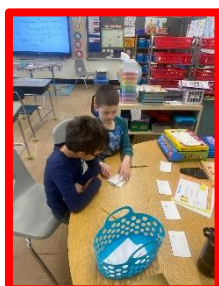
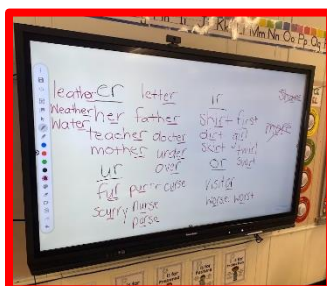
