We dissected owl pellets for our final STEAM activity of the school year!



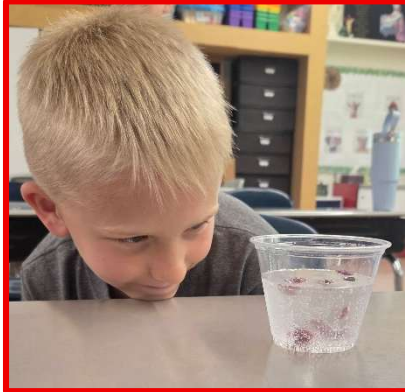

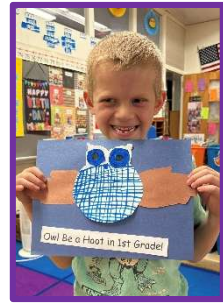
