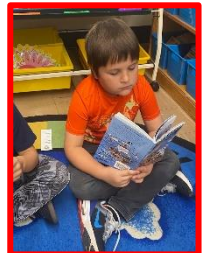
On Tuesday the 1-year-olds played with the tunnel and they loved it!

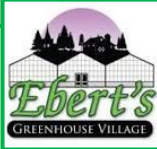

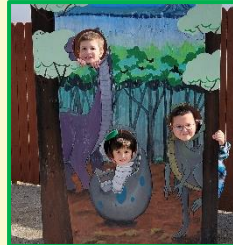
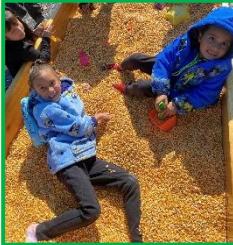


Our 3<sup>rd</sup> graders took time to practice their readings for Friday Mass.
