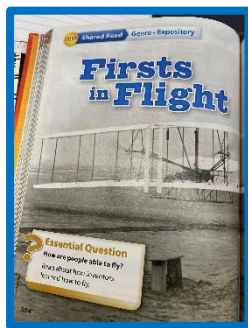
We practiced patterns this week. We did A-B-A-B patterns all by ourselves!



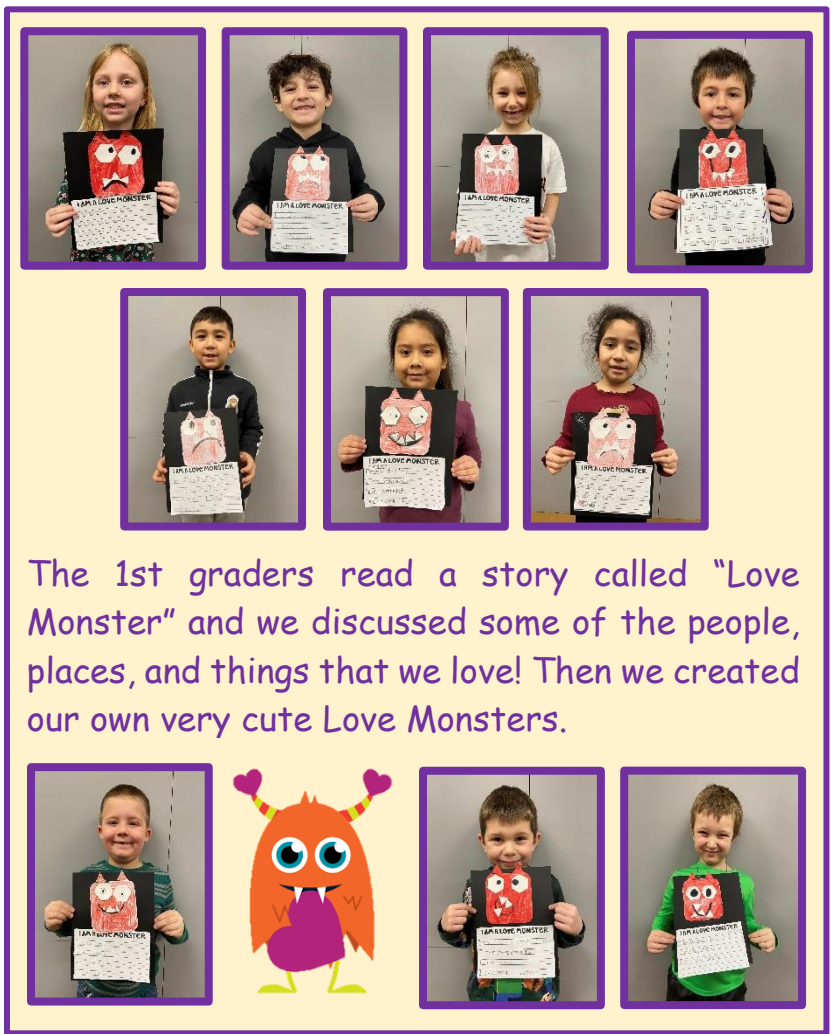
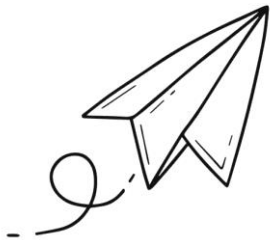

We like to go the park and watch baseball.

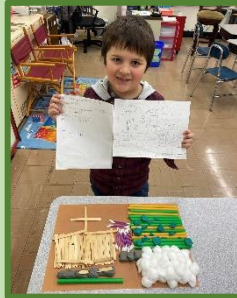
