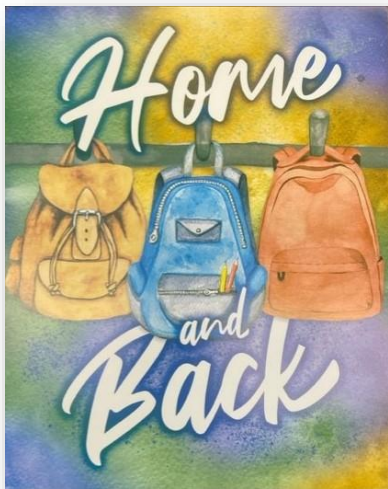

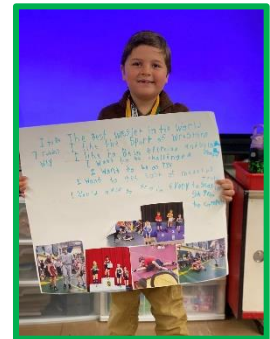
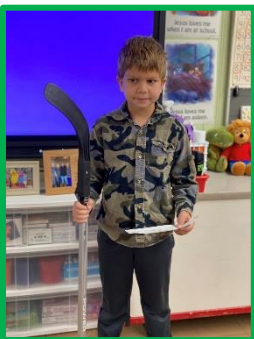

Our 2-year-olds got lots of play time this week! We got to have some fun on the playground - we love going down the slide!



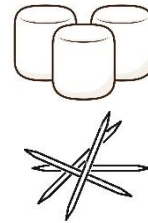
When we were not on the playground we were working on fall masterpieces in the classroom! The kids love making crafts for their parents! These tissue paper leaves were so fun to make!
