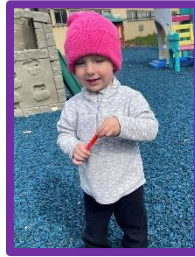
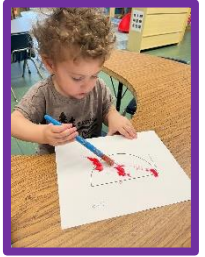
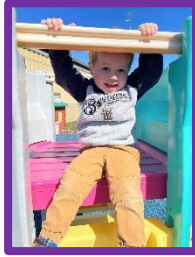
The 5K class read "The Very Hungry Caterpillar" then made caterpillar crafts and our older kids did some butterfly watercolor painting.

We sure were busy in Childcare! We played outside, made watermelon and pineapple art and blew bubbles outside!



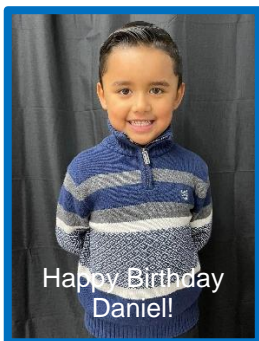

We love to go camping and watching movies. Going fishing is one of our favorite things to do as a family.

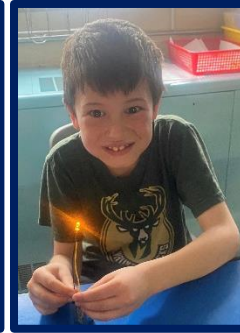
WHAT IS A PRAYER, SAINT OR TRADITION THAT IS IMPORTANT TO YOUR FAMILY?
