CHILDCARE RATES UPDATE

Ages 6 weeks - 3 years old \$6.00 per hour
Ages 3 years and older \$5.00 per hour

Registration fee will stay the same
at \$25 per new child

Supply Fees will remain the same at \$15 per
child; billed 2x per year (Jan. 1st & July 1st)

Snack Fee begins June 1, 2026
\$2.00 per snack / per child
This is charged only if child does
not have a snack from home

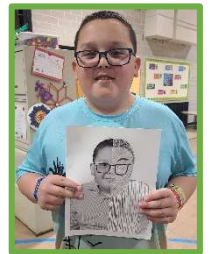
