PICNIC WITH THE PRINCIPAL



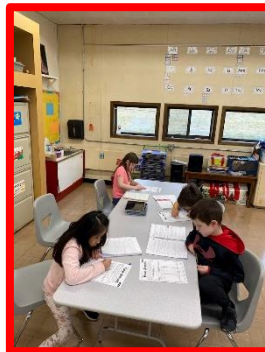
