Here's just a sneak peek of the animal habitat dioramas that the 1st graders began this week during STEAM!

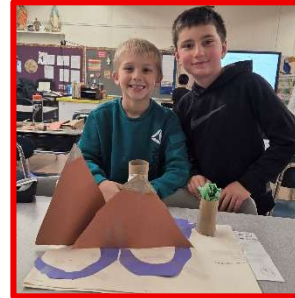


Students had so much fun making giant snowballs on Monday! The snow was the perfect consistency!

3RD GRADE

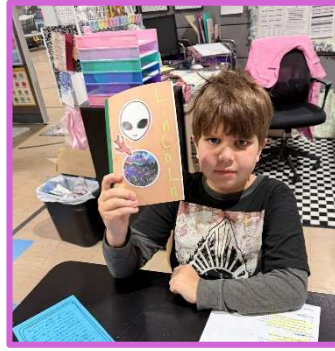
We are working hard on our division in math this week!
