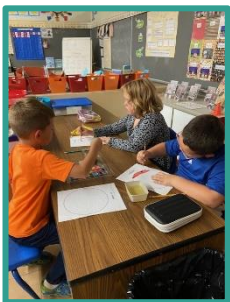

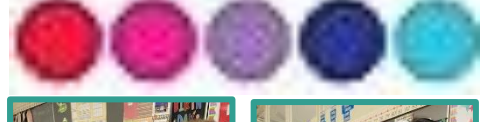


STEAM
