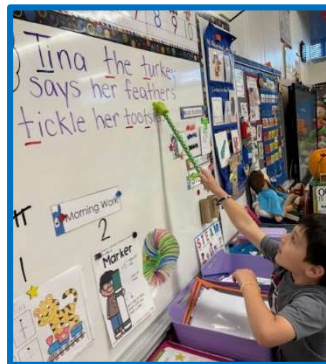

Some of our families attended the Mayville Fire Department Open House on Tuesday and had fun with checking it all out!

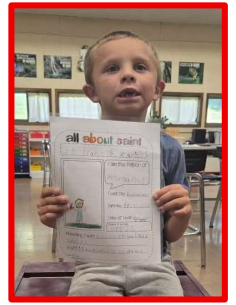
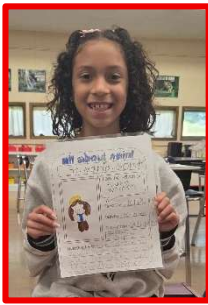


1ST GRADE

3RD GRADE

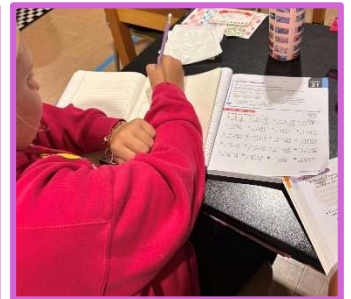
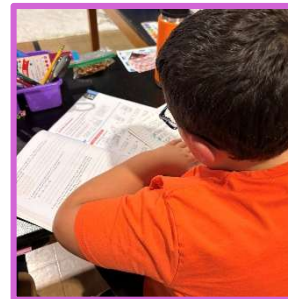
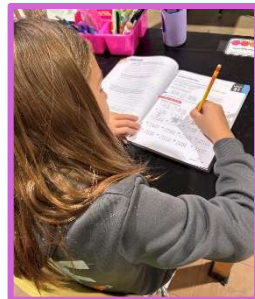
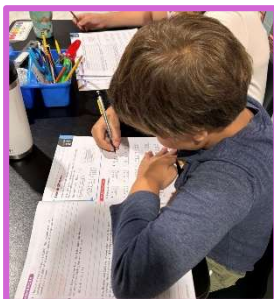
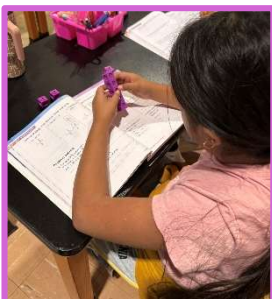

4TH GRADE

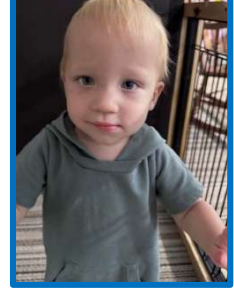
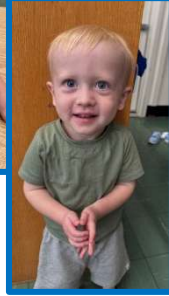
